I write to advise you that I was appointed Administrator of The Loft Shop Limited, ["the Company"] on 29 July 2011. In accordance with paragraph 46[3] of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, I enclose formal notice of the appointment of Administrator on form 2.12B.

As a consequence of my appointment, amounts owing to you by the Company rank as unsecured claims. It is the responsibility of the directors of the Company to prepare a statement of affairs; therefore it would be most helpful if you would forward complete the enclosed proof of debt and attach a detailed statement of your debt with the Company at your earliest convenience.

If you consider that you have supplied goods to the Company subject to reservation of title, I should be grateful if you would notify me of this fact within the next 14 days, so that I may forward a "Reservation of Title Questionnaire" to you for completion.

If your claim relates to leased or hired equipment, you should forward to me proof of ownership and a detailed description of the items concerned together with early settlement values, if applicable.

If you are of the opinion that your claim is other than that of an unsecured creditor, if you have any security for your claim, or if you consider that you have title to any assets in the Company's possession, please inform me at your earliest convenience and provide copies of any agreement you may have with the Company or document of title.

Please note that, pursuant to paragraph 43 of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, my appointment restricts the rights of any creditor to enforce any security over the Company's property or to re-possess goods in the Company's possession under hire purchase, conditional sale, chattel leasing, or retention of title agreements.

Should you have any information concerning matters which you believe should be included in that report, then I should be grateful if you write to me setting out any facts which you believe should be considered for inclusion.
