Your fund merger explained

What is happening?

The merger will be applied to your account on **Monday 25 April 2016**. As a result you will see the new fund on your valuations, statements and any other correspondence you receive from us after this date.

The merger is subject to shareholder approval, so if it isn't approved we will write to you to let you know.

Why is the change happening?

Following a review of their fund range, with a view to enhancing efficiencies in the management and marketing of products with similar strategies, BNY Mellon propose to simplify and consolidate some of the mixed asset fund types in their range.

The merging fund invests predominantly in a mixed portfolio of funds for which Newton is the investment manager, whereas the receiving fund invests directly in securities and is also allowed to invest in other funds.

BNY Mellon believes that the receiving fund will have greater prospects of growing assets under management as a directly invested portfolio is more flexible in targeting required exposures across changing market conditions. Additionally, BNY Mellon expects that a fund with growing assets under management will be more cost-effective and result in a reduction in overall cost to investors.

Change to the Total Expense Ratio (TER)

The TER represents the annual percentage charge made to investors by the fund manager. It is the sum of the fund manager's Annual Management Charge (AMC) and all other additional expenses they incur running the fund.

As a result of the merger the TER which applies to your fund holding will increase from 0.80% to 0.81%.

Will the merger affect my fund holding?

As a result of the merger there may be changes to your holding in the fund. These are described below. Please speak to your financial adviser about these changes in order to understand what they mean for you.

Value of your fund holding

The merger may affect the value of your fund holding as explained below under the heading 'Will the merger cost me anything?'. You may wish to discuss the impact of this change with your financial adviser.

Risk Profile

As a result of the merger, the fund's risk profile may change. You may wish to discuss the impact of this change with your financial adviser. A Key Investor Information Document is enclosed for the new fund for your reference. This is the fund group's standard document and may not reflect the charges when accessing the fund through OMW. Change to Reimbursed Rebate*

The Reimbursed Rebate which applies to your account will decrease as a result of the merger from 0.07% to 0.00%. On your statement this will show under the 'Customer Account Credit' section.

*This is an annual amount the fund manager refunds to us, which we return to you in the form of extra units in your account. This rebate is effectively a discount on the fund manager's charges, negotiated on your behalf by Old Mutual Wealth and expressed as a percentage of the fund value.

Will the merger cost me anything?

All costs and expenses of the merger will be payable out of the property of the merging fund. BNY Mellon estimates that the total costs and expenses of the merger will be around 0.30% of the fund value of the merging fund.

Can I switch out of my current fund holding in advance to avoid being involved in the merger?

Yes. You can switch your holding in the Newton Managed Income –U fund at any time up until 9:00am on Thursday 21 April 2016.

What will happen if I am making regular Direct Debit payments?

If part or all of a regular Direct Debit payment is allocated into the Newton Managed Income –U fund we will automatically redirect it into the Newton Multi Asset Income –U fund. We will automatically reinvest any new investments intended for the Newton Managed Income –U fund into the new fund.

What will happen if I am using Old Mutual Wealth's phasing or rebalancing options? Your phasing and rebalancing arrangements will automatically continue after the merger, with the new fund replacing the previous one.

Do I need to take any action?

You do not need to take any action unless you wish to make an alternative choice from our extensive range of funds.

OBJECTIVES AND INVESTMENT POLICY

OBJECTIVE

To provide income with the potential for capital growth over the longer term by investing in a broad diversified multi-asset portfolio.

POLICY

The Fund will:

- invest anywhere in the world;
- follow a fully flexible asset allocation approach;
- invest in company shares (i.e. equities) and similar investments;

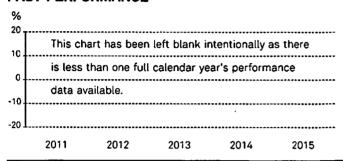
