

What is a kWh?

A kWh stands for kilowatt-hour - it's the unit we use to measure energy usage. A single kWh will power a 15 watt energy-saving lightbulb for almost 3 days!

What makes up a bill?

This breakdown of our costs to supply energy is an average across residential customers on all payment types & based on the average of EDF Energy customers' consumption in 2012 (4,365 kWh of electricity and 15,899 kWh of gas per year).

VAT: set by government at 5% for all domestic energy charges.

Social & environmental: we're obligated to take part in government programmes that help vulnerable customers and reduce CO₂ emissions.

Operating: the cost of keeping our call centres open and our customers' accounts running smoothly.

Delivery: what we pay owners of the wires, pipes and meters that supply the energy to customers' homes.

Wholesale: we produce our own electricity but we also buy electricity and gas from wholesale market.

Profit and loss: Like most companies, we aim to make a profit. In 2012, EDF Energy made a profit (EBITDA) of £1,667m. Our residential business - supplying energy to customers' homes - made a loss of £62m.
