

8 Authority: *Authoritativeness* is the degree to which a source is credible and trustworthy. Authority is often associated with expertise, reputation, and the ability to provide accurate information. Authority can be established through various means, such as peer review, citations, and endorsements from other experts in the field.

2. **Date of exposure:** Date of contact with the source. Starting on the Day of exposure, add the number of days of exposure ending on the Day of entry into the United States. Do not include the date of departure from the source. An example of a 14-day exposure would be the following: exposure to a source on 10/10/01, exposure period ending 11/14/01. If you report the date of departure from the source as the date of exposure, you will be charged with 14 days of exposure. *Example:* 10/10/01-10/24/01.

10 **Multiple signature and electronic identity.** Again, searching for specific evidence that the law may be the leading separator is not likely to be fruitful.
