

## **Shire Consulting Pension Scheme**

I have now completed my check of your Pension Scheme Returns for the years ended 5 April 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010. This letter is a closure notice. Thank you for your help during my check.

I have sent a copy of this letter to your practitioner.

### My decision

I do not need to amend your returns.

My colleague, Ian Porteous, wrote to you on 3 April 2013 about making a protective assessment in respect of a potential scheme chargeable payment. This was in connection with a loan made to Shire Investments (UK) Limited during the year ended 5 April 2009.

I can confirm that no assessment has been made in respect of this matter.

### What to do if you disagree

If you disagree with our decision, you or your adviser can appeal. You need to write to us within 30 days of the date on this letter, telling us why you think our decision was wrong. We will then contact you or your adviser to try to settle the matter. If we cannot come to an agreement, we will write to you and tell you why. We will then offer to have the matter reviewed by someone who has not previously been involved. We will also tell you about your right to go to an independent tribunal.
