2 The Principal Employer hereby constitutes itself trustee (which expression shall mean the trustee or trustees for the time being of the Scheme) to hold the policy or policies providing the Assurances on trust for the purposes of the Scheme in accordance with this deed and the Rules.

3 The Trustee hereby undertakes and declares that it will pay or procure payment from the Principal Employer and any Associated Employer of the premiums payable from time to time under the Assurances.

4 The Administrator of the Scheme as required under the Chapter II of Part II of the Finance Act 1970 shall be the Trustee.

5 The power of appointing new or additional trustees of the Scheme shall be vested in the Principal Employer and the Principal Employer may by deed appoint individual trustees of the Scheme in place of itself remove any such individual trustee appoint a new trustee in place of any individual trustee who dies retires or is removed and appoint additional trustees provided always that there shall not at any time be less than two trustees unless a corporation is a trustee nor more than five trustees.
