A Special Purpose Entity or Vehicle is defined as a limited company, or a limited partnership, created to fulfill narrow, specific or temporary objectives, to isolate a financial risk, a specific taxation risk or a regulatory risk.

Typically:

- they have no employees and no non-financial assets
- they have little physical presence beyond a 'brass plate' confirming their place of registration
- they are always related to another corporation, often as a subsidiary
- they are resident in a different territory from the territory of residence of the related corporations. In the absence of any physical substance to an enterprise, its residence is determined according to the economic territory under whose laws the enterprise is incorporated or registered
- they are managed by employees of another corporation, which may or may not be a related one. The SPE/SPV pays fees for services rendered to it and in turn charges its parent, or other related corporation, a fee to cover these costs. This is the only production the SPE/SPV is involved in, although it will often incur liabilities on behalf of its owner and will usually receive investment outcome and holding gains on the assets it holds
